***General Goal(s):***

Students will be able to broaden their knowledge for several different famous Georgia Patriots

***Specific Objectives:***

1. Describe Georgia’s Patriots
2. Compare and Contrast Georgia’s Patriots

Pen/Pencil/Markers

Scissors

Other art materials as needed

***Step-By-Step Procedures:***

1. Each student is to independently research a famous Georgia Patriot and learn everything about this person. Teacher should provide a list of famous Georgia Patriots for students.
2. Student should create a scrapbook page for the selected patriot. Teacher should provide an example of a completed page.
3. Students will present completed pages to classmates as a class presentation.
4. Teacher should compile a scrapbook of all the pages created by students.

***Extensions for Gifted Students:***

Student is to pretend he/she is a famous "Georgia Patriot" and create his/her special scrapbook page.
